



The Moore Police Department Hiring Notice

A physical agility test will be conducted by the Moore Police Department for the purpose of selecting applicants to proceed in the process to become a Police Officer I.

The physical agility test has been scheduled for February 10, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. Applicants will need to report to the southeast corner of the end zone of the football field at Moore High School, located at 300 N. Eastern. You will need to park in the parking area south of the main complex and gymnasium, but west of the field.

You will need to wear comfortable clothing (Gym type clothing) and bring soft-soled tennis shoes for running.

You will need to report 15 minutes prior to test time in order to show your drivers' license and sign up for the test. Everyone must sign a medical release and release of liability form at the time of testing. Without a signed medical release or release of liability, you will not be able to test for this position. Medical release forms will be made available on the dates of testing.

Applicants who pass the Physical Agility Test will proceed to the written test (same day). There is a \$15.00 fee for the written test.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be between the ages of 21/45 and pass a physical, written, psychological, and polygraph exam, along with a medical evaluation, and thorough background investigation. Applicants must have a high school diploma, or a GED with 30 college credit hours from an accredited college or university. Other restrictions may apply.
