## MAYOR'S CORNER

Dear Citizens,

Thank you for taking the time to read our newsletter. This is just one of the ways we try and communicate with you.

Most of the time I inform you of all the new business openings in town and all the happenings in our city. We will still have that, but my newsletter today should be titled "That Stinks".

We are about to start construction on a new wastewater treatment plant. Our current plant has had numerous problems and has smelled so bad for so many years. The federal government, EPA, as well as the State DEQ has mandated us to replace and upgrade our sewer plant. This new plant has a conservative cost estimate at \$32 million. We have applied for and received grant money for \$2 million, as well as the State Water Resource Board has loaned the city the other \$30 million.

The good news is the smell will go away and the city will reduce its pollution into the environment.

The bad news is it will cost \$30 million and the rates will have to be raised to pay for it. We will be phasing in those increases over the next couple of years.

There are still many good things happening in our city, and on behalf of the City Council, thank you for being a part of it.

## INCREASE IN RESIDENTIAL SEWER SURCHARGE

Effective July 1, 2009, residential sewer utility customers will be charged an additional \$5 per month to assist with construction costs of the new wastewater treatment facility. Our current surcharge is \$1.75 and the new surcharge will raise the monthly rate to \$6.75.

Customers' usage rates will not change. Senior citizens (62 years and above) with an annual household income below \$24,000 may apply for a discounted rate. Please contact City Hall.

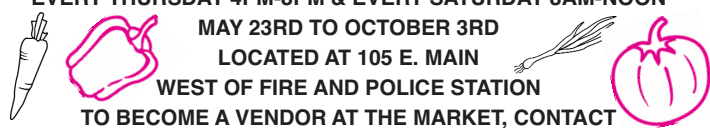
