The residential street improvement projects voters passed November 9, 2021 have completed engineering plans with bid letting to occur in April and May. City Council approval of the contracts should take place in May and June with construction on these projects beginning mid-summer. All seven projects are scheduled to be completed by the end of 2022, weather permitting. Updates on all seven projects will be added to the City's website at cityofmoore.com.
