

According to CPD Notice 14-11, issued on June 10, 2014, low/moderate income summary data must be taken from the 2014 data. When the project was originally identified, the low/moderate income summary data was pulled from the 2010 data. Therefore, the national objective determination has been changed to Urgent Need.

The project location is located in the heart of the disaster area and is crucial to the disaster recovery efforts in the area. To replace the low income housing the city lost in the 2013 tornado, a new low income housing development is being built using CDBG-DR funds. A new Sewer Interceptor was needed to support the additional housing units in the area.
