PURPOSE:

The City of Moore (City) is requesting Quotes from qualified professionals for design services for neighborhood "gateways".

BACKGROUND:

The City of Moore completed the "Infrastructure Recovery and Implementation Plan" (IRIP) to guide the recovery efforts from the May 20, 2013 tornado. The IRIP included potential neighborhood gateway improvements that would help brand and revitalize the affected neighborhoods. Four concept gateway plans were developed as part of the IRIP. The City of Moore now desires to fully develop the gateway concepts into site-specific gateway plans with landscape and hardscape features.

Six (6) neighborhood gateways will be located in public right-of-way at selected locations (see map), listed here in the order of priority:

- 1. Foxglove Addition
- 2. JD Estates Addition
- 3. Eastmoor Addition
- 4. Kings Manor Addition
- 5. Baer's Westmore Addition
- 6. Southmoor Addition

The gateway design should be informed by the results of a visual preference survey (completed in March 2015), the history of the area, and/or existing architectural styles found in the neighborhood. Gateway designs may include, but are not limited to:

- Monuments
- Signs
- Sculptures
- Banners/Flags
- Markers/Identifiers
- Landscaping
- Decorative Lighting
- Decorative street pavers

The consultant will be responsible for developing simplified construction documents to allow for bidding and use by in-house construction crews.

The City will allow a maximum of 90-days for the completion of the Gateway Plans and Specifications, however the work shall be done in phases. As gateway plans are completed they shall be immediately made available to the City for bidding and construction purposes.

SCOPE OF WORK

Gateway enhancements and accompanying design elements are intended to create a sense of place and indicate entrance into a unique neighborhood within the 2013 Tornado Area. The gateway designs should be informed by the results of a visual preference survey (completed in March 2015), the history of the area, and/or existing architectural styles found in the neighborhood.

Potential elements may include but are not limited to:

- Monuments
- Signs
- Sculpture
- Banners/Flags
- Markers/Identifiers
- Landscaping
- Decorative Lighting
- Decorative street pavers

Task 1: Project Initiation. The Consultant will participate in 1 kick-off meeting with the Moore project team to accept input on project; review existing conceptual plans; detail design approaches; establish common objectives and milestones; determine the priorities and timelines for the project and respective roles and responsibilities. At the conclusion of the meeting the Consultant will summarize the data received reflecting the understanding and perspectives of the participants.

Task 2: Initial Data Collection & Assessment. The Consultant will complete a comprehensive evaluation of the selected gateway locations. The consultant will review all available information resulting from public input strategies to date. NOTE: Project Scope shall not include survey work. The City will provide the consultant with project boundary, parcel, and ownership information. If survey is deemed necessary, the City will provide survey services.

Task 3: Progress Meetings. The Consultant will conduct a minimum of 4 progress meetings with the project team to report overall progress and next steps and to review preliminary designs, when applicable.

Task 5: Evaluation. The Consultant will determine gateway improvements that will have maximum appropriate impact for each neighborhood and establish construction cost estimates. The Consultant will evaluate each identified neighborhood for placemaking or branding to establish and encourage neighborhood identity.

Task 6: Detailed Design Concepts. The Consultant will prepare a minimum of one detailed design concept for each identified neighborhood/location as outlined below. These concepts should be considered preliminary and are subject to modifications.

- a. Freehand or drafted front elevation, side elevation, and site plan.
- b. Incorporate color to depict gateway appearance and materials.
- c. Drawn to scale, include scale.
- d. List of all elements and materials on right side of illustration.
- e. Label overall dimensions.

Task 7: Final Plans. Construction plans for each neighborhood gateway to include site plan, elevation plan and materials specifications. Limited profile plans are needed only when including street paver details. Final Plans shall be submitted in the following formats:

- a. Five (5) construction plans and specifications on 24x36 paper, bound.
- b. One (1) electronic copy of the Final Plans and Final Color Renderings in PDF format;
- c. Five (5) construction plans and specifications and Final Color Renderings on 11x17 paper, unbound.

Location Map: Foxglove Addition 19th St and Eagle Dr








Location Map: JD Estates Addition SE 4th St. and Whispering Oaks








Location Map: Kings Manor Addition SW 11th St. and Telephone Rd








Location Map: Sidewalk/Multi-Use Trail SE 4th, from Eastern Ave to Bryant
