Bagged Trash Reminder

Bagged trash, including grass clippings, must be bagged and placed inside a polycart for pick-up.* Bagged trash set by the curb will not be picked up. Residents may purchase a second cart for \$7 by contacting Customer Service at 405-793-5032.

Community Emergency Response Training (CERT)

The CERT program educates people about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact their area and trains them in basic disaster skills such as fire safety, light search and rescue and disaster medical operations. This training will be provided by members of our Fire Department, Police Department, EMSTAT and Emergency Management.

Using CERT training learned in the classroom and during exercises, individuals can assist others in their neighborhood, workplace or school following an event when professional responders are not immediately available to help.

Natural for the training are neighborhood watch, community organizations, communities of faith, school staff, workplace employees and other groups that come together regularly for a common purpose, but individuals not affiliated are welcome to learn the skills that are useful in disaster and everyday life.

Class is a total of 20 hours and will be held on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6:30-9:30 p.m. starting April 4 and ending on April 20. We will also have another class in May from May 9 through May 25. City of Moore residents will have priority registration for both classes. Registration now open.
