Stormwater Tips

As we head into the winter, here are some helpful tips to keep our storm drains clean through the colder months:

- 1. Shovel as soon as possible after a snowstorm. As a result, less ice will form and you won't need to use as much salt or de-icer
- 2. Use safe and effective alternatives to salt Remember that salt is not effective below 15 degrees Fahrenheit. Sand or kitty litter will give you traction when it's too cold for salt.
- 3. Plant native species, that are salt tolerant, near paved areas. Not only will these species be able to survive despite the road salt, they will also act as a protective buffer for local waterways.



4. Make sure the storm drains closest to your property are clear of snow and other debris. Do not shovel snow into storm drains since they empty directly into local creeks.



Turner Ave. Project

S. Turner Ave between SE 4th and East Main St. will begin reconstruction in early Spring of 2022. This reconstruction project is expected to take 180 days from the start date and is necessary to provide a bypass option once the SE 4th Railroad Underpass Project begins. Turner Ave. will be closed at East Main St. and S 4th for the duration of the project. Residents on Turner Ave. will be allowed access but through traffic will not be allowed. The improvements will consist of a new concrete street with a 5' bike lane in each direction as well as a 5' sidewalk on each side of the street. In addition, storm drainage improvements will be constructed with the street improvements to improve the overall drainage from SE 4th St. to Main St. adjacent to Turner Ave.
