

SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION AND NOTICE

Under and by virtue of Section 27, Article X, of the Oklahoma Constitution and the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma, and Acts complementary, supplementary, and enacted pursuant thereto, and Resolution dated August 16, 2021, authorizing the calling of an election on the propositions hereinafter set forth, I, the undersigned Mayor of the City of Moore, Oklahoma, hereby call an election and give notice thereof to be held in the City of Moore, Oklahoma, on the 9th day of November, 2021, for the purpose of submitting to the registered, qualified voters in said City the following propositions:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

"Shall the City of Moore, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the amount of Eight Million Six Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$8,640,000) to provide funds for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, improving or repairing streets or bridges in said City, to be owned exclusively by said City, and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds as it falls due, and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed the rate of 7 per centum per annum, payable semiannually and to become due serially within 20 years from their date?"

The specific projects for which at least seventy percent (70%) of the proceeds of the aforesaid street or bridge bonds shall be expended, and the dollar amounts for each such project shall be as follows:

1. Resurfacing of Kelsi Drive between SE 5 th Street and SE 11 th Street, including necessary curb and guttering, storm drainage improvements, sidewalks, streetscape and water line replacement	\$1,707,275
2. Resurfacing of Timber Creek Way between SE 38 th Street and SE 41 st Street, including necessary curb and guttering, storm drainage improvements, sidewalks, streetscape and water line replacement	596,500
3. Resurfacing of Nottingham Way between NW 27 th Street and NW 23 rd Street, including necessary curb and guttering, storm drainage improvements, sidewalks, streetscape and water line replacement	1,320,838
4. Resurfacing of Hillcrest Drive between Cass Avenue and NW 27 th Street, including necessary curb and guttering, storm drainage improvements, sidewalks, streetscape and	1,274,118

| 6. | Resurfacing of SW 27 th Street between I-35 Service Road and the end of the Cul-de-Sac, including necessary curb and guttering, storm drainage improvements, sidewalks, streetscape and water line replacement | 1,085,250 |
| 7. | Resurfacing of Classen Avenue between SW 4 th Street and north of SW 3 rd Street, including necessary curb and guttering, storm drainage improvements, sidewalks, streetscape and water line replacement | 576,931 |
| 8. | Engineering and design expenditures pertaining to the resurfacing and widening of Broadway Avenue from two to five lane roadway with turn lanes between South 19 th Street and Willow Pine Avenue, including necessary curb and guttering, storm drainage improvements, sidewalks, streetscape and water line replacement | 471,500 |
| 9. | Engineering and design expenditures pertaining to the resurfacing and widening of Eastern Avenue from two to four lane roadway with turn lanes between SE 19 th Street and Broadway Avenue, including necessary curb and guttering, storm drainage improvements, sidewalks, streetscape and water line replacement | 246,500 |
| 10. | Engineering and design expenditures pertaining to the resurfacing and widening of Telephone Road from four to five lane roadway with turn lanes between SW 19 th Street and SW 34 th Street, including necessary curb and guttering, storm drainage improvements, sidewalks, streetscape and water line replacement | 471,500 |

PROPOSITION NO. 2

"Shall the City of Moore, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the amount of Eight Million Two Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$8,210,000) to provide funds for the purpose of constructing and equipping a new Animal Shelter in said City, to be owned exclusively by said City, and levy and collect an annual tax,

in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds as it falls due, and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed the rate of 7 per centum per annum, payable semiannually and to become due serially within 20 years from their date?"

The specific projects for which at least seventy percent (70%) of the proceeds of the aforesaid Animal Shelter bonds shall be expended, and the dollar amounts for each such project shall be as follows:

Project	Cost
1. Construction and equipping of a new Animal Shelter to be located at 3500 South Service Road, Moore, Oklahoma	\$8,210,000
Total:	\$8,210,000

That only the registered, qualified voters of the City of Moore, Oklahoma, may vote upon the propositions as above set forth.

The polls shall be opened at 7:00 o'clock a.m. and shall remain open continuously until and be closed at 7:00 o'clock p.m.

Such election shall be conducted by those precinct officers designated by the County Election Board of Cleveland County, Oklahoma, which officers shall also act as counters and certify the results in the case of regular elections and certify the results thereof as required by law.

The number and location of the polling places and the names of the persons who shall conduct said election shall be provided by the County Election Board of Cleveland County, Oklahoma.
