! ENTRY PASS POLICY

Effective May 20, 2026 all individuals ages 13 and under must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, with a photo ID, in order to enter The Station Recreation Center. Parents or guardians must remain in the facility at all times. Entry passes do not allow re-entry into the facilities. If a patron exits the facilities, a new entry pass will need to be purchased for re-entry.


