

Curb Side Trash Pickup

Refuse is normally collected between 7:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. On your designated day you should place your polycart out to the curb no later than 7:00 am and it must be removed within the same day.

Holiday Schedule- if your pick up day falls on one of the four Holidays that our trucks do not run, New Year's Day, Independence Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day, your refuse will be collected on Wednesday in that same week. Reminders are transmitted on your water bill.

Your polycart must be placed within ten feet of the curb and three feet from any obstacles with the arrow on the lid facing the street.

If your polycart is full of acceptable refuse you may place up to five trash bags of yard waste (leaves, grass clipping or twigs) at the curb at no extra charge. Over 5 bags you will be charged 50 cents per bag on your water bill.

Unacceptable items that will not be picked up include:

No household chemicals, unused insecticides, pesticides, fertilizers, etc.

No oil, gas, solvents, antifreeze, etc.

No refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners with Freon units.

No batteries, tires or paints.

No shingles.

Do not put hot ashes from your fireplace, wood burning stoves or charcoal grills in your polycart as this can cause the possibility of fire. If the polycart is damaged because of this action, the customer will be charged for the polycart at the current cost of replacement.
