# Fire Extinguisher Safety Tips

- As a general rule, firefighting should be left to the fire department.
- Only adults who know how to use portable fire extinguishers should use them.
- Before trying to fight a fire, make sure that everyone is leaving the house, someone is calling 9-1-1, the fire is not bigger than a small wastepaper can and you can get out.
- Fire extinguishers should be mounted close to an exit.
- Inspect portable extinguishers monthly and have them serviced annually.
- As a general rule, portable fire extinguishers for the home should have a rating of at least 2-A:10-BC
- Fire extinguishers are one element of a fire response plan, but the primary element is safe escape.
- Every household should have a home fire escape plan and working smoke alarms.
