## Stormwater Savvy

Summer is in full swing, so let's make sure we can continue to enjoy our lakes, creeks, and streams. You can help reduce stormwater pollution by following a few easy tips:

1. Don't fertilize your lawn if the forecast is for rain. Heavy downpours will wash the fertilizer away into the storm sewer system. Always follow product instructions, don't over-apply, and use a gentle lawn sprinkler after fertilization.
2. Mulch your grass clippings instead of bagging. It saves time, is good for your grass, and won't contribute to bulky waste in the landfill. Never dump grass clippings in a drainage channel!
3. Drain your swimming pool to your sanitary sewer clean-out, not to the street.
4. Have a septic system? Ensure proper maintenance to reduce stormwater runoff contamination from nitrates and harmful bacteria.
5. Pick up your pet waste- it is not fertilizer! Dog feces have higher phosphorous concentrations than found in cow and swine manure and can severely impact water quality and landscaping (including grass).

## Moore Animal Welfare and Adoption Center



### Greetings from the Moore Animal Welfare and Adoption Center!

The Shelter primarily houses cats and dogs, but occasionally we have other pets available. The Shelter currently has a variety of cats and dogs available for adoption. The fee for adopting a cat or dog is \$70.00. This fee includes spay or neuter of the animal, vaccinations such as canine/feline core vaccines and Rabies vaccine (\* if the animal is old enough to

receive a Rabies vaccination), dogs are tested for Heartworms and cats are tested for FIV/Felv. All dogs and cats receive a microchip, a first deworming, flea/tick preventive and their first month of heartworm prevention all included in the adoption fee. Acceptable forms of payment are debit/credit card, money order and check with a valid driver's license.

We are open for business Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and on Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. We are closed on Sunday and major holidays. We are located at 3900 S. I-35 Service Road between SW 19th Street and Indian Hills Road on the East service road. We are approximately 2 miles south of SW 19th Street.
