



Moore Storm Shelter Rebate Program

Registration ran January 22nd - February 28th 2014

Priority was given to *citizens who sustained total or substantial property loss in May 20th tornado**

Approximately 4,600 residents applied; approx. 350 of those fall into the *Priority Group**.

Paid for by the American Red Cross; City will receive a grant for \$3.75 million

Rebates will be up to \$2500

Must be owner-occupied residences within the City of Moore to be eligible

Plan to provide 1500 storm shelters with the \$3.75 million

Total # of storm shelters permitted in Moore in calendar year 2013 was 1600. The City has permitted 2,165 shelters from 5/21/13- 5/1/14.

The City of Moore estimates there are 5,500 registered residential storm shelters in the city. There are approximately 23,000 residential properties in Moore
