Notice is hereby given that Moore Public Works Authority, hereinafter called the "Owner" will receive sealed bids from Contractors by the Owner, at the Office of the Purchasing Agent Purchasing Division, Moore City Hall 301 N. Broadway, Suite 142, Moore, Oklahoma 73160 until 1:30 P.M. CST on the 3rd day of May, 2022.

Ward 1 Residential Street Improvements Timber Creek Way and Kelsi Drive Project Funded by The City of Moore 2021 General Obligation Bond BID NUMBER 2022 - 007

All bids from Contractors received at said time will be opened for the construction of Ward 1 Residential Street Improvements Timber Creek Way and Kelsi Drive, consisting of:

Construct approximately 948 linear feet of Roadway Reconstruction on Timber Creek Way from SE 41st Street to SE 38th Street. The reconstruction includes grading surfacing, signing and traffic control.

Construct approximately 2409 linear feet of Roadway Reconstruction on Kelsi Drive from SE 5th Street to SE 11th Street. The reconstruction includes grading surfacing, signing, and traffic control.

All work shall be performed, and all construction and material used and furnished shall be in accordance with the Plans and Specifications prepared by CEC Corporation, and on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent, for the Moore Public Works Authority / City of Moore, Oklahoma

General Contractors may purchase a complete set of Plans and Specifications from CEC Corporation at 4555 W. Memorial Road, Oklahoma City, OK 73142 for the non-refundable payment of \$300.00 per set, plus shipping and handling. Plans and Specifications shall not be scanned and re-calculated by contractor thru other plan rooms, and/or posted to websites.

Each Bidder shall accompany his original bid, filed with the Purchasing agents, with a certified or Cashier's Check on a solvent bank located in Oklahoma or a Bidder's Bond, in the amount of five (5) percent of the amount bid, as a

guarantee of his ability to perform the contract bid upon, and that he will enter into a written contract with the Owner to perform said work and/or furnish said materials in accordance with said plans and specifications and furnish the required bonds within seven (7) days after the acceptance of his bid.

The owner will retain the deposit and use it for liquidated damages in case the successful bidder fails to enter in said contract and furnish the required bonds provided for in the specifications within the time required. Deposit of unsuccessful bidders will be returned upon the execution of the Contract and required bonds.

Each bidder shall accompany his bid with a sworn statement in writing that the Bidder has not directly or indirectly entered into an agreement, expressed or implied, with any other bidder concerning the price or amount of such bid or any bids, the limiting of the bids or bidders, the paying to anyone any money for promotion expenses, the parceling or farming out to any bidder or bidders or other persons of any part of the contract or any part of the subject matter of the bid or of the profits thereof.

Construction, maintenance, and Statutory Payment Bonds in the amount of 100% of the contract price with a Corporate Surety licensed in Oklahoma and approved by the Owner and Engineer, will be required for the faithful performance of the contract, and the bidder shall state in the proposal the name and address of the Surety or Sureties who will sign this bond in case the contract is awarded to him. The Maintenance Bond required will guarantee the repair of all damage due to supply of faulty equipment, improper materials, or sub-standard workmanship for a period of two (2) years after the FINAL acceptance of the work by the Owner.

The bids filed with the Purchasing Agent Purchasing Division will be opened at 2:00 P.M. CST, on the 3rd day of May, 2022 and considered by Moore City Council at the City Council meeting to be held on May 16th 2022 in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Moore, Oklahoma. All bids shall remain on file at least forty-eight (48) hours thereafter before a contract will be made and entered into thereon. Bids received more than ninety-six (96) hours prior to the Bid Opening will be returned.


Contract is to be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible qualified bidder.
