Notice is hereby given that Moore Public Works Authority, hereinafter called the "Owner" will receive sealed bids from Bidders by the Owner, at the Office of the Purchasing Agent Purchasing Division, Moore City Hall, 301 N. Broadway, Suite 142, Moore, Oklahoma 73160 until 01:45 P.M. CST on the 21st Day of September 2021.

36-inch PVC Gravity Sewer Pipe Material

Project Funded by The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) SLSRF Program &/or OWRB LOAN FAP-19-0003-L

All bids received at said time will be opened for the supply of 36-inch PVC Gravity Sewer Pipe material FOB job site to Contractor selected by MPWA for the construction of gravity sewer Improvements. MPWA will be bidding the Gravity Sewer Construction & Improvement project simultaneously & construction is projected to start by the second week of October 2021 & last approximately 300 Calendar days.

Supply approximately 7702 Lineal Feet of 36-inch Closed Profile PVC Pipe as manufactured by VYLON Pipe, FOB job site in Moore, OK, and in compliance with ASTM F-1803 with Pipe Stiffness of 46 psi complete per Plans, Specifications. Sewer pipe installation contractor will be selected by MPWA, and the installation by Contractor shall be in accordance with the Gravity Sewer PVC Pipe Installation Manual. Bedding, backfilling, general installation requirements shall comply with ASTM D-2321.

This project when completed will transport wastewater from the existing Lift Station located west of Sunny Lane on 34th Street to the new Southeast Lift Station under construction on Indian Hills Road east of Indian Hills Road.

All material furnished shall be in accordance with the Plans and Specifications prepared by Eagle Consultants, Inc., and on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent, for the Moore Public Works Authority / City of Moore, Oklahoma.

Each Bidder shall accompany his original bid, filed with the Purchasing Agent, with a certified or Cashier's Check on a solvent bank located in Oklahoma or a Bidder's Bond, in the amount of five (5) percent of the amount bid, as a guarantee of his ability to perform the contract bid upon, and that he will enter into a written contract with the Owner to furnish said materials in accordance with said plans and specifications and furnish the required bonds within seven (7) days after the acceptance of his bid.

The Owner will retain the deposit, and use it for liquidated damages in case the successful bidder fails to enter in said contract and furnish the required bonds provided for in the specifications within the time required. Deposit of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned upon the execution of the Contract and required bonds.

Each bidder shall accompany his bid with a sworn statement in writing that the Bidder has not directly or indirectly entered into an agreement, expressed or implied, with any other bidder concerning the price or amount of such bid or any bids, the limiting of the bids or bidders, the paying to anyone any money for promotion expenses, the parceling or farming out to any bidder or bidders or other persons of any part of the contract or any part of the subject matter of the bid or of the profits thereof.

The supplier shall guarantee the repair of all damage due to supply of faulty equipment, improper materials, or materials of sub-standard quality workmanship for a period of one (1) year after the FINAL acceptance of the construction contract work by MPWA.

Construction, Maintenance and Statutory Payment Bonds in the amount of 100% of the contract price with a Corporate Surety licensed in Oklahoma and approved by the Owner and Engineer, will be required for the faithful performance of the contract, and the bidder shall state in the proposal the name and address of the Surety or Sureties who will sign this bond in case the contract is awarded to him. The Maintenance Bond required will guarantee the repair of all damage due to supply of faulty equipment, improper materials, or sub-standard workmanship for a period of one (1) year after the FINAL acceptance of the work by the Owner.

This project is to be financed through a grant from the Federal Government funded by The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) SLSRF Program AND/OR through a loan from the Oklahoma Water Resources Board OWRB LOAN FAP-19-0003-L

The bids filed with the Purchasing Agent Purchasing Division will be opened at 02:00 P.M. CST, on the 21st day of September 2021, and considered by Moore Public Works Authority at the MPWA meeting to be held on October 4, 2021 in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Moore, Oklahoma. All bids shall remain on file at least forty-eight (48) hours thereafter before a contract will be made and entered into thereon. Bids received more than ninety-six (96) hours prior to the Bid Opening will be returned.

Contract is to be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible qualified bidder.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality in the bidding.

A **Pre-bid Conference** will be held on this project at 2:00 P.M. CST on the 8th day of September 2021, in the City Council Chambers, Moore City Hall, Moore, Oklahoma.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any & all bids in accordance with the Oklahoma Competitive Bidding Act.

Conditional bids shall not be accepted.
