Moore's Fire Station #2 has moved. The new address is 636 NW 5th from 725 NW 12th.

With the relocation of fire station #2 to NW 5th and City Avenue, we wanted to make everyone aware of the new warning signal light located at the intersection. The light will be activated when the fire apparatus is leaving the station. NW 5th Street has a dangerous curve in front of the fire station so drivers need to be cautious when the lights are on because emergency vehicles are entering the roadway.
