All bids from Contractors received at said time will be opened for the construction of Southeast Lift Station Improvements, consisting of:

Site grading & drainage, Concrete structure to install screens, lift station with four pumps, channel monster, odor control system, electrical control building, flow meter, trolley hoist structure, yard piping, fence, gate, gravel drive.

All work shall be performed and all construction and material used and furnished shall be in accordance with the Plans and Specifications prepared by Eagle Consultants, Inc., and on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent, for the Moore Public Works Authority / City of Moore, Oklahoma.

General Contractors may purchase a complete set of Plans and Specifications from Reidprographics (RPG) at 6800 N. Shartel, Oklahoma City, OK 73116 for the non-refundable payment of \$250.00 per set, plus shipping and handling. Individual sheets and specification sections may also be purchased directly from Reidprographics. Plans & Specifications shall not be scanned and re-circulated by contractor thru other plan rooms, and/or posted to websites.

Each Bidder shall accompany his original bid, filed with the Purchasing Agent, with a certified or Cashier's Check on a solvent bank located in Oklahoma or a Bidder's Bond, in the amount of five (5) percent of the amount bid, as a guarantee of his ability to perform the contract bid upon, and that he will enter into a written contract with the Owner to perform said work and/or furnish said materials in accordance with said plans and specifications and furnish the required bonds within seven (7) days after the acceptance of his bid.

The Owner will retain the deposit, and use it for liquidated damages in case the successful bidder fails to enter in said contract and furnish the required bonds provided for in the specifications within the time required. Deposit of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned upon the execution of the Contract and required bonds.

Each bidder shall accompany his bid with a sworn statement in writing that the Bidder has not directly or indirectly entered into an agreement, expressed or implied, with any other bidder concerning the price or amount of such bid or any bids, the limiting of the bids or bidders, the paying to anyone any money for promotion expenses, the parceling or farming out to any bidder or bidders or other persons of any part of the contract or any part of the subject matter of the bid or of the profits thereof.

Construction, Maintenance and Statutory Payment Bonds in the amount of 100% of the contract price with a Corporate Surety licensed in Oklahoma and approved by the Owner and Engineer, will be required for the faithful performance

of the contract, and the bidder shall state in the proposal the name and address of the Surety or Sureties who will sign this bond in case the contract is awarded to him. The Maintenance Bond required will guarantee the repair of all damage due to supply of faulty equipment, improper materials, or sub-standard workmanship for a period of one (1) year after the FINAL acceptance of the work by the Owner.

This project is to be financed by a loan from the Oklahoma Water Resources Board OWRB LOAN FAP-19-0003-L.


The bids filed with the Finance Purchasing Division will be opened at 2:00 P.M. CST, on the 27th day of October, 2020, and considered by Moore Public Works Authority at the MPWA meeting to be held in November 2020 in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Moore, Oklahoma. All bids shall remain on file at least forty-eight (48) hours thereafter before a contract will be made and entered into thereon. Bids received more than ninety-six (96) hours prior to the Bid Opening will be returned.

Contract is to be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible, qualified bidder.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality in the bidding.

A **Mandatory Pre-bid Conference** will be held on this project at 11:00 A.M. CST on the 16th day of October, 2020, in the City Council Chambers, Moore City Hall, Moore, Oklahoma.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids in accordance with the Oklahoma Competitive Bidding Act. Conditional bids shall not be accepted.
